INSTALLATION OF NEW

ARCHBISHOP: As you know, Pope Francis has appointed Bishop John Wilson as Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Southwark. Archbishop-elect Wilson succeeds The Most Reverend Peter Smith, who has been Archbishop of Southwark since 2010. Archbishop-elect Wilson, Auxiliary Bishop of Westminster since 2015 and previously a priest in the Diocese of Leeds, will be the 11th Archbishop of Southwark and his **Episcopal Installation will be celebrated in St George's Cathedral, Southwark, on 25th July 2019 at 11am.**
