**PILGRIMAGE:** the first Parish Pilgrimage will take place on **Saturday, 21 September 2019 to Aylesford Priory in Kent.** The Parish will be subsidising the cost of the pilgrimage and for those who **wish to travel by coach, the cost will be £5 per head including children.** There will be someone in the porch at all masses this weekend to collect the money and confirm your booking.
