**Confirmation Programme 2020/21:** we aim to start the Programme for 2020/21 in January. More details will be announced towards the end of the year.

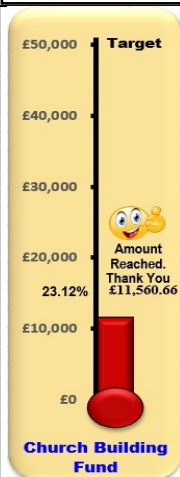
