Message from Fr Anton. In view of the recent tightening of the Government guidelines, it is even more important that we play our part and keep our churches open. Please continue to ensure that face coverings/masks are worn over the nose and mouth. It has been suggested that rather than hold people up on entry and leave them queuing outside, particularly as the temperature begins to drop, everyone should come prepared with their names and contact details on a piece of paper which they then hand to the Steward on entry. So please come prepared and help ensure a smooth entry and exit from the Church.

First Holy Communion: the Sacrament will be celebrated on **17th and 24th October 2020**. There will be 2 masses on Saturday, 17 October at 10am and 12 Noon (please note there will be no 9.30am mass on that day). The remaining children will receive Communion on Saturday, 24 October at 10.30am. Again there will be no 9.30am Mass that day. Please keep our children in your prayers.

Confirmation Programme 2020/21: we aim to start the Programme for 2020/21 in January. More details will be announced towards the end of the year.
