Message from Fr Anton. Congratulations to our second group of children who received **Holy Communion on Saturday morning**. **The final Group will be receiving the Sacrament for the first time on Saturday, 31st October** again at 9.30am. Please keep our children in your prayers.

CORONAVIRUS: As you are aware, the Government has increased the Covid restrictions and we are now officially in Tier 2. Thankfully, we are still allowed to continue with our services but it is imperative that we continue to observe the government requirements: **by wearing a face covering that covers both nose and mouth, sanitising on entry and exit; maintaining a space between households and, of course, providing contact details.**

The stewards are there to ensure the guidelines are being followed and I am grateful to you for your support.
