

The Novena is usually started on Good Friday and continues for 9 days until Divine Mercy Sunday - the Sunday after Easter. There will be a special celebration at 3pm when there will be Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration and we will also pray the Chaplet. I do hope you will be able to join in this great Feast of Mercy.
