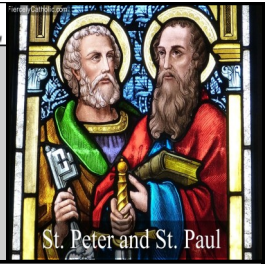

Understanding the Holy Mass - we continue this weekend with the explanation of the Holy Mass covering the Liturgy of the Eucharist.
