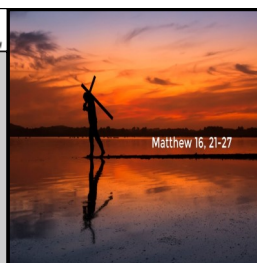

The Archdiocese of Southwark will be holding their **annual service for those that have been harmed by abuse** on the **30th September 2026, at 6.30pm at St George's Cathedral**. The service will be lead by Archbishop John Wilson and is an opportunity for the archdiocese community to express their solidarity and compassion to those that have been hurt by abuse and our commitment to building safe environments for all. Please attend if you are able.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the process for adults to become Catholic, receive the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist or deepen their understanding of the faith. The journey is completed through study sessions, prayer and within a local parish, leading to full membership at the Easter Vigil. Our course at Kidbrooke will begin after the summer holidays. The Catholic Education Service (CES) acts on behalf of the Catholic Bishops' Conference to support Catholic education.
