**Confirmation 2026:** if your child is aged at least 12 or over (usually in Year 8) and wishes to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2026 they will need to submit an application form before 31 December 2025. Application forms can be found on the small table in the porch. Parents, it is important that you discuss this with your child and ensure that they are prepared to commit to this programme before submitting an application.

**RCIA** (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the process for adults to become Catholic, receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist, or deepen their understanding of the faith. The journey is completed through study sessions, prayer, and reflection within a local parish, leading to full membership at the Easter Vigil. Our course at Kidbrooke is about to begin.
