Fr Simon Peter's induction - Canon Victor Darlington, Episcopal Vicar for the South East, has advised that Fr Simon Peter's formal induction as Parish Priest will take place on Friday, 19 December 2025 at 6pm. There will be a Mass followed by a celebration (venue yet to be agreed). You will find 2 forms in the porch: one, in which you are invited to indicate whether you will be able to attend and the second, to indicate whether you are able to help in any way, by contributing food, drink or cash donations towards the party.

Christmas Raffle - tickets will be on sale after all masses. £1 a strip or £5 for 6 strips. There is also a basket in the porch for any donations towards the prizes.

Confirmation 2026: if your child is aged at least 12 or over (usually in Year 8) and wishes to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2026 they will need to submit an application form before 31 December 2025. Application forms can be found on the small table in the porch. Parents, it is important that you discuss this with your child and ensure that they are prepared to commit to this programme before submitting an application.

**First Communion Programme 2026** - this programme will start in January 2026. If your child is in Year 3 and above and has never received First Holy Communion and wishes to do so, please collect a form from the church porch. Completed forms should be posted through the Presbytery letterbox by **no later than Wednesday, 31 December 2025.** Please ensure the forms are completed clearly and in block capitals.

**RCIA** (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the process for adults to become Catholic, receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist, or deepen their understanding of the faith. The journey is completed through study sessions, prayer, and reflection within a local parish, leading to full membership at the Easter Vigil. Our course at Kidbrooke is about to begin. If you are interested in finding out more, please speak to Fr Simon Peter. Application forms can also be found in the porch.
