Pentecost Novena - the nine days Pentecost Novena will start on **Friday, 11 May 2018.** This Novena Prayer will be said during mass each day. If you cannot join in this at Mass, please collect a copy from the Porch and say the Novena at home with your family.

The Archbishop is encouraging all of us to help implement these changes and I thank you in advance for your cooperation.
