



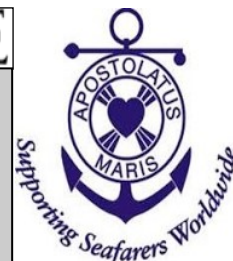

**Altar Servers Training:** 21st July at 10.30am. New members are welcome. Please encourage your children to join this ministry.

**Peter's Pence:** this is our offering to the Holy Father to support Church needs, human initiatives and social promotion projects as well as to the support of the Holy See. The Pope as Pastor of the whole Church uses these funds to support the needs of poor dioceses, and others in need. **We will be collecting funds for this purpose throughout the month of July** - please put your donations in the box marked Peter's Pence in the porch (on the right side (as you leave the church) of the main doors. The Archbishop is encouraging all of us to help implement these changes and I thank you in advance for your cooperation.
