Message from Fr Anton

Induction: My induction is on Sunday 21st October at 5pm. Bishop Pat Lynch is going to be the main celebrant. In the coming days/weeks I will be discussing this with the different groups. Please keep this in your prayers.

The Social Committee are looking for volunteers to assist with preparing the Hall and the catering arrangements for the day. If you can help, please speak to a member of the Social Committee or email your details to the office or come along to the next meeting of the **Social Committee on Tuesday, 9 October 2018 at 7pm.**

Pious Associations: they are very important for the spiritual growth of the parish. Please consider volunteering yourself to be part of a prayer group such as Legion of Mary, St Vincent de Paul Society, Padre Pio Prayer group or Mothers Prayers. If you are interested please meet me after the Mass.

We are introducing the **Divine Mercy prayers at 9.15am on Thursdays** before the morning Mass. Please do come along and join in.

Instrumentalists: We have a fine, beautiful church. Mostly we use it for just once a week and only for an hour or so. I understand that we are all busy with our lives. But when we come together we must make full use of that hour in fully singing and praising the Lord. Choirs play an important role in our liturgy. I would very much appreciate it if you have a skill, or you know somebody who can play a musical instrument such as piano, violin, flute, guitar bass and lead, please encourage them to come forward for the greater glory of God. Ask them to meet me! We need a good choir for all three masses. Thank you.

Blessed Sacrament Adoration: In our diocese many parishes have started perpetual adoration on one day every month, starting from morning 8am to evening 8pm. The importance of this is to allow all of us to find some quiet time with our Lord. There is a group already working in the Kent area preparing the parishes for Blessed Sacrament Adoration. Further details will follow later.

Sr Francis McPartlin: the second collection this weekend is to enable us to present Sr Francis with a gift from the Parish which we intend to present to her at a small get together next weekend in the

Parish Hall on **Saturday, 6 October** after the 6pm Mass. Everyone is welcome but please bring some food and/or drink (particularly wine if you are a wine drinker) to share with everyone and let's make it a joyous occasion.

Mass Intentions: Why not offer a mass for yourself, a loved one or a friend or indeed for the repose of the soul of a loved one. **Brown Mass intention envelopes can be found in the Church porch.** Please note that a donation of at least £10 should be made. If there is a shortfall, the balance has to be made up by the Parish.

They also ask for our prayers for those around the world who are less fortunate than us. Envelopes will be in the porch next weekend and we will collect them on the weekend of 6/7 October.
