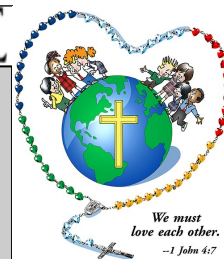

Message from Fr Anton

Induction: the arrangements for my induction which is on Sunday 21st October at 5pm continue. Bishop Pat Lynch is going to be the main celebrant and there will be a reception after Mass at St James' Church Hall, which, as you will know, is a short walk from our church.

The Social Committee are looking for volunteers to assist with preparing the Hall and the catering arrangements for the day. If you can help, why not come along to the next meeting of the **Social Committee on Tuesday, 9 October 2018 at 7pm.**

Stewardship in the Parish: attached to your newsletter (and extra copies are available in the porch) is a form which I would invite **every parishioner over the age of 8** to complete, telling me how you are currently helping out, and either what more you might want to do or (in the case of some parishioners) how you might like to help the Parish in the future. **I want our Parish to be a vibrant community and I need your help in making this happen.** Please do not be put off if you haven't heard or been involved in some of these ministries, together we can set them up. If you want to find out more about any of them, please do not hesitate to have a word with me. **All completed forms should be posted** through the letterbox in the Presbytery by **the end of October**. Blessed Sacrament Adoration: In our diocese many parishes have started perpetual adoration on one day every month, starting from morning 8am to evening 8pm. The importance of this is to allow all of us to find some quiet time with our Lord. There is a group already working in the Kent area preparing the parishes for Blessed Sacrament Adoration. Further details will follow later.

Sr Francis McPartlin: we intend to present with a gift from the Parish in the Parish Hall on **Saturday, 6 October** after the 6pm Mass. Everyone is welcome but please bring some food and/or drink (particularly wine if you are a wine drinker) to share with everyone and let's make it a joyous occasion.
