**Induction:** A big thank you to the Social Committee and everyone who made my induction last Sunday such a memorable occasion. Your donations of food and wine, your presence and your prayers were much appreciated. Now the real work begins!

### **Help: Your Parish needs you.**

We urgently need a plumber to look at the toilets in the Hall. If you are able to help or can recommend someone please have a word with Fr Anton or contact the Parish office.

### **Stewardship in the Parish:**

I have not received many completed forms yet. There is still time to complete and it is important that you do so as soon as possible so as to help inform the way we continue to build our Parish. Forms are available in the Porch. Please ensure your personal details are clearly printed.

**R**emembrance Tree: at the end of all Masses next weekend, you will be invited to place the names of your loved Ones on the "tree" and Fr Anton will pray especially for their souls.

**B**lessed Sacrament Adoration: In our diocese many parishes have started perpetual adoration on one day every month, starting from morning 8am to evening 8pm. The importance of this is to allow all of us to find some quiet time with our Lord. There is a group already working in the Kent area preparing the parishes for Blessed Sacrament Adoration. Further details will follow later.
