FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME: our programme for 2019 draws to a close next weekend when we are blessed to have **28 children receiving the Eucharist for the first time at 12 pm next Saturday and on Sunday at the 10am Mass.** Please keep them all in your prayers and let us pray that this will be the first of many more visits to our Lord in the Eucharist. I would also like to remind parents that until such time that these children can come to Mass on their own, that it is their responsibility to ensure that their children come to Mass every weekend and as often as possible.

ARCHBISHOP PETER SMITH:

as some of you may be aware from the media, Pope Francis has accepted the resignation of the Most Reverend Peter Smith as Archbishop of Southwark and his subsequent retirement. The Holy Father has also appointed **Bishop John Wilson, currently an Auxiliary Bishop in Westminster,** as the next Archbishop of Southwark. In the interim, and pending the installation of Bishop John as the new Archbishop, Peter Smith has been appointed Apostolic Administrator of the Archdiocese. **Please keep them both in your prayers.**

We are also looking for other volunteers to help with the children's liturgy. If you think you would like to join this group please come along to the meeting on the 30th June.

SJFK 200 CLUB: The next draw will take place on **Sunday, 7 July** after the 10am Mass.

It is still not too late to join and the "Club" remains open to new members. This is a simple way to support your Church and still have a chance of winning a cash sum each month. The aim of the Club is to raise funds for the Parish buildings renewal scheme. More details of the scheme can be found in the leaflets in the porch.

The Feast of Corpus Christi (next Sunday) is a liturgical solemnity celebrating the real presence of the body and blood of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, in the elements of the Eucharist—known as transubstantiation. By tradition, Catholics hear Mass then go in procession through the streets of their parish whilst praying and singing. The Eucharist, is placed in a monstrance and is held aloft by the priest during the procession. Next Sunday after Communion, the First Holy Communion children will lead us in a procession around the Church before we return for the Final Blessing.

Gift Aid/Standing Orders: if you are a UK taxpayer, and sign a declaration, gift aiding your weekly donation, the Church will be able to claim (from HMRC) **25p for every £1** you donate, at no extra cost to you. If you have not already signed up, why not consider doing so now. Forms are available in the porch.

Standing Orders are an effective and efficient way to make your weekly donations. It also saves us counting and banking the cash every week and may also save you having to ensure that you have enough cash on you for the weekly collection! Again forms are available in the porch if you would like to set up a standing order.
